CENTRAL NANO: Advanced materials and nanotechnologies for high added value products and process industries - travelling

How to reach JIC-INMEC:

- a) **By public transport** - Take the number 12 tram (goes via city center) or bus number 53 to the end stop (Technologický park) and continue straight by the Red Hat building uphill along the main road. At the junction with the CEITEC building turn left and the JIC INMEC building will be on your right-hand side.
- b) **By car** - Follow the route of the tram number 12 until you reach the end of the route. Cross the tramline at the Red Hat building and continue uphill. At the junction with the CEITEC building turn left and the JIC INMEC building will be on your right-hand side. You can park in the surroundings of the building.

How to reach Brno:

a) By plane:

BRNO AIRPORT

- It is a small airport so there is only limited number of flights.
- Direct flights:
 - o Brno – London-Stansted (operated by Ryanair)
 - o Brno – London-Luton (operated by WizzAir)
 - o Brno – Munich (operated by BMI Regional)
 - o Brno – Eindhoven (operated by WizzAir)

- There is a direct **bus no 76** going from the **Brno Airport to the Brno - City Center**. Ticket is approximately 25 CZK (0,9 EUR). It takes approximately 20 minutes to get from the airport to the city center. There are 2 buses per hour.

VIENNA AIRPORT

- How to get from **Vienna Airport to the Brno – City center**
 - o There is a direct bus going from Vienna Airpot to Brno – City center
 - o It goes every two hours and the journey takes app. 2 hours 10 minutes. Ticket costs approximately 340 CZK (12 EUR)
 - o Bus stop is just in front of the arrival hall (the buses are yellow, so you will not miss them☺)
 - o You have to book and buy tickets in advance

PRAGUE AIRPORT

- How to get from Prague Airport to the Brno – city center
 - o There is a direct bus from the **Prague Airport to Prague Main Railway station** (marked by „**AE Express**“ sign), ticket costs 60 CZK (app. 2 EUR)
 - o From Prague Main Railway Station you can take railjet/EC/IC train which goes to Brno. There is a train every hour (depends on the time of your arrival). Journey takes approximately 2 hours 30 minutes. Ticket is approximately 200 – 300 CZK (app. 7 EUR – 11 EUR). You can check the timetable here:
